IMPORTANT!!

CLINIC and END OF YEAR INFORMATION

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Although it seems early to be discussing this, school policy changed in January about medications left in clinic after spring terms. I wanted you to hear it from me first and I'm sure it will be repeated the next few months more than you care to hear. I ask you keep it in mind and share this information with other parents in the spirit of looking ahead.

If your student receives medication during the school day, please note that ALL medications (prescription and non-prescription) MUST be picked up by a parent, guardian or parent designated adult by the last day of school instruction and/or if the child transfers to another school. The school is unable to properly store medications over the summer. Medications (regardless of cost) that remain in clinic will be disposed of on the last day of school instruction, after dismissal.

This apparently has been a very big issue in the past. Please arrange your schedule and look ahead to the last week of school to come in and see me.
